Proposed by National Grid Ventures (NGV) Supplementary Non-Statutory Public Consultation

Friday 8 September - Friday 3 November 2023

We previously held a non-statutory public consultation, from Monday 24 October to Sunday 18 December 2022, on our proposals for LionLink (formerly known as EuroLink) – LionLink will be the first electricity link of its kind between Great Britain and the Netherlands enabling the cross-border flow of electricity and the direct connection to Dutch offshore wind.

Based on the feedback received at the non-statutory consultation, we have carried out additional environmental and technical assessments as part of the options refinement process. These assessments have identified an alternative corridor for the underground onshore cable to the north of Southwold, which may reduce impacts on designated sites of ecological importance. We have also identified an alternative landfall site at Walberswick, which could reduce access constraints and traffic impacts.

Following the identification of an alternative Southwold cable corridor and Walberswick landfall site, we will be holding a supplementary non-statutory consultation to enable stakeholders and local communities to provide their feedback on these options. This consultation will run from Friday 8 September to Friday 3 November 2023 – see reverse side for more details.

Key Benefits

LionLink could supply 1.8 gigawatts (GW) of electricity, which will be enough to power up to approximately 1.8 million homes, as well as contributing to our national energy security and to the UK's climate and energy goals.
