## SC/21/3 Review of ROSPA report on play equipment on the green

The report was considered in detail and the following items in particular were noted:

- a. The report would be "marked up" with the comments agreed by the Safety Committee and presented to the WPC November meeting for their discussion and endorsement
- b. There were multiple recommendations in the ROSPA report about "Zip-tying" the safety mats together. This had never been raised in a report before and there was concern among the committee that doing this could in itself create a trip hazard, so it was decided to recommend to WPC not to proceed with those specific recommendations
- c. The "Pirate ships" were a particular concern and after discussion it was agreed that both Pirate ships would immediately be taken out of use, pending a decision on their future by WPC, but the Safety Committee would regretfully be recommending their removal
- d. All other recommendations in the RSPA report were considered reasonable and would be recommended to be progressed in accordance with the "marked up" copy produced for WPC

# SC/21/4 Consideration of maintenance needs existing memorial benches

A discussion took place about the current benches and **it was agreed** that a suitable period had elapsed since the last survey and a re-survey should be undertaken of all the benches and recommendations brought forward regarding any maintenance needs to the full Council
