As a community near to the site, we are concerned about the lack of plans and location for the safe disposal of nuclear waste. Local communities should not be exposed to the risks that the lack of such plans places on us. Permitting should not be provided until such plans are in place. In addition, we remain very concerned that EPR reactors around the world have no track record of being operationally sound. We note that the reactor at Taishan has been shut down for well over a year and that the reactors recently opened in Finland were closed almost immediately after operations began and remain closed still.

We note that EDF (NNB) makes statements that seem to indicate that they understand the design and operational problems, but this cannot be accepted on face value particularly as they have been unable to fix and restart the troubled plants. Until and unless the investigations into the reactor pressure vessels are complete and a foolproof resolution is implemented and found operational on existing plants including at Hinkley C (given that Sizewell C is meant to be an exact replica), no permit should be given for Sizewell C.

Please provide your comments on the proposed decision for a new bespoke application for an environmental permit received from NNB Generation Company (SZC) Ltd:

As a community located directly on the North Sea Coast, less than 10 miles from the Sizewell C site, we are extremely concerned about the impact of the water inflow and discharge on sea life and, in particular, fish. Our local economy, based on tourism and a pristine marine environment, would be devastated by potential large fish kill related to the operation of Sizewell C. We support the views shared by many experts recently that the fish kill numbers have been underestimated by the developer and that the real numbers, in excess of 800 million fish kill, are possible. It is essential that full and evidence-based analysis takes place prior to permitting. Moreover we would insist that EDF install the most advanced AFD and that no short-cuts be allowed. We note that EDF was refused permission to reduce the protections to which it agreed at its Hinkley C site and we would urge the EA to require similar at Sizewell C. It should be clear that no amendment to the DCO in this regard would be entertained at a later time.

As a community near to the site, and with concerns about the environmental and noise impact of the Sizewell development related to generators for desalination, we believe that there need to be strong assurances, prior to permit and construction, with relation to the use of desalination during construction and the possibility of desalination as a permanent water source for operation. There would need to be a firm and irrevocable commitment to large scale consultations on the use of generators for desalination and that any such possibility would have to meet the highest standards of assessments.
