

Litter bins and signage in Walberswick

For the past five years, two villagers have been picking litter from The Street between the end of St Andrews Close and the junction with Dunwich Road near the water tower.

It is estimated that they collect 15-20 black bin bags of litter each year, usually in three sessions, as well as already full bags and other items that have been fly tipped.

18 months ago WPC was contacted on this matter and it was suggested that we put up two signs saying PLEASE TAKE YOUR LITTER HOME WITH YOU. One near the parking area for drivers coming towards the village, and another just after Adams Lane for drivers leaving Walberswick. It was also suggested that a bin be installed in the parking area.
