The RNLI provides a 24-hour search and rescue service around the UK and Ireland up to 100 nautical miles offshore. It has 238 operational lifeboat stations, 458 lifeboats (including relief fleet) and employs 1500 lifeguards covering 240 beaches around the coastline with 389 lives were saved in 2022.

On Monday (4 March 2024) the Royal National Lifeboat Institution (RNLI) celebrated 200 years of saving lives at sea, thanks to volunteers giving their time to save others, funded by public donations.
