The RNLI provides a 24-hour search and rescue service around the UK and Ireland up to 100 nautical miles offshore. It has 238 operational lifeboat stations, 458 lifeboats (including relief fleet) and employs 1500 lifeguards covering 240 beaches around the coastline. In 2020 lifeboats were launched 8,239 times, aided 8,374 people of which 239 lives were saved.
