**5. ANY OTHER BUSINESS.**

- a) A request for funding for a CD player for the weekly fitness group was discussed. It was agreed to suggest that the request be made through the Village Hall Committee so the equipment could be used by village hall users.
- b) As no decision on the planning application for the Drift building had been received, a letter had been sent to the Head of Planning. Agreed that if no response by next week to write stating intention to go ahead with the building.

- d) Agreed to allow the perimeter fence of the Sportsfield to be treated with weed killer. Mr Hunt would arrange and the Trust agreed to pay for the Roundup.
- e) Agreed to inform the Harbour Master that work to the piling between the ferry stage and the slipway would be carried out this month.
- f) It was agreed to renew the posts at the access to the mooring stages and the slipway and to provide new barriers and combination padlocks. Agreed to ask Highfield Engineering to carry out the work whilst on site. Clerk to research barriers.
- g) Mr D Webb produced a rough drawing of proposal for piling for the East Point Bay. He would draw up detailed plans for submission to the Environment Agency.
