SC/19/1 Chairman's Welcome. The Chairman welcomed Councillors

SC/19/2 Open Forum – There being no members of the public present, no issues were raised

SC/19/3 To consider the Minutes of meeting of 31st October 2018 for accuracy and for the chairman to sign as a true record

It was **AGREED** to adopt the minutes presented. The chair was given authority to sign these as a true record. The draft minutes of this meeting will be presented to the next formal WPC meeting

SC/19/4 Status update on Playground Action Plan

SC/19/5 Slide on the Green

Councillor Lewis updated the meeting on the findings of the independent assessment, and it was **AGREED** that he would now seek quotes for part or total replacement to be presented to a full WPC meeting for agreement on a way forward

SC/19/6 Removal of wooden posts prior to the fete

This was discussed and **AGREED** that Councillor Lewis will remove any further damaged posts before the fete takes place, and also mark all remaining posts with a white ring in the same manor as used on the new posts on the harbour carpark. After the Heritage Hut works are completed, suitable new posts will then be reinstated to replace those removed

The format and method of the survey delegated by WPC to the Safety Committee to be undertaken was **AGREED** and this would be concluded in time for a proposal to be put to the WPC meeting in September
