The minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of the Parish Council held on Monday 27th July 2020 at 7.15pm.

057/20-21 Chairman's welcome.

The Chair welcomed those present to the meeting.

Apologies were received from Cllrs. Richardson and Sutton and **ACCEPTED**.

Cllrs Lewis and Winyard agreed to look again at the possibility of enclosing the notice board at Stock's Lane. They will discuss this further with the Clerk and come with a new proposal to the Council.
