

June 2025:

Walking to the coast on the footpath from Spong Bridge the state of the salt marsh becomes clear; it is bone dry.

Unusual weather saw East Anglia having the highest amount of March sunshine on record, particularly in Norfolk and Suffolk. For example, Wattisham in Suffolk recorded over 220 hours of sunshine, exceeding the previous record by over 22 hours. With an average of 228.9 hours of sunshine across the month, the UK has also recorded its sunniest April since records began in 1910.

The combined East Anglia rainfall for March and April 2025 was 28mm, which is the fifth driest March to April rainfall total for East Anglia based on records going back to 1871.

Fascinating data, and nature is incredibly resilient but please think twice about any form of burning - and keep your fingers crossed for more rain.
